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IEPA CHARGER GRANT PROGRAM (VW MITIGATION TRUST FUND)

- \$12.6 now available, anticipate 25-50 awards
- Only public DCFC for light-duty vehicles
- Eligible applicants: private orgs and companies NOT government entities
 - government entities may serve as site hosts
- Applications must include at least <u>one charging station</u> with a minimum of two standalone chargers, minimum 4 connectors, in at least <u>2 different</u> <u>priority areas</u>

Priority Area 1: Chicago metropolitan ozone nonattainment area.
Priority Area 2: Metro-East St. Louis ozone nonattainment area.
Priority Area 3: Seven counties, each with 1% or more of the total affected VW vehicles (Champaign, DeKalb, LaSalle, McLean, Peoria, Sangamon, and Winnebago Counties)

- No requirements for EJ locations, receive additional points
- 80% of eligible costs, min. award \$125,000; max. \$480,000





\$100M USDA HIGHER BLENDS INFRASTRUCTURE INCENTIVE PROGRAM

- Goal to increase the sale and use of biofuels derived from U.S. agricultural products
- Grants for infrastructure for higher blends of ethanol and biodiesel
- 50% of eligible costs
- Applications due 11/21/22





OPENING SOON Illinois Electric Vehicle Rebate Program

REBATE AMOUNTS

- **\$4,000** for the purchase of an all-electric vehicle, not an electric motorcycle
 - Beginning July 1, 2026: \$2,000
 - Beginning July 1, 2028: \$1,500
- **\$1,500** for the purchase of an all-electric motorcycle



OPENING SOON Illinois Electric Vehicle Rebate Program

IMPORTANT DATES

- 2nd rebate cycle opening soon: Nov 1, 2022 Jan 31, 2023
- Purchasers must apply during an open rebate cycle and within 90days of vehicle purchase
- ??For 1st cycle, vehicles must be purchased on or after July 1, 2022??





\$5B NATIONAL ELECTRIC VEHICLE INFRASTRUCTURE FORMULA FUNDING PROGRAM (IIJA)

- IDOT to receive \$148M over next 5 years
- Minimum of 4 DCFCs placed every 50 miles, less than 1 mile off corridor
- Illinois' plan approved by FHWA 9/27/22
- Public outreach meetings ongoing
- Drive Electric Illinois





\$2.5B DISCRETIONARY GRANTS FOR COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVE FUEL INFRASTRUCTURE (IIJA)

- National, competitive 5-year program
- Fill gaps in publicly accessible EVCI + other alt fuels
- Up to 80% of project costs, including planning & community engagement activities
- Must prioritize projects in rural areas, low- and moderate-income neighborhoods and communities with limited parking or high MUD vs singlefamily homes
- Eligible entities include states, local governments, MPOs, etc.



Utility Beneficial Electrification Programs (CEJA)

- ComEd and Ameren required to file BE Plans with the Illinois Commerce Commission for programs that start no later than 1/1/2023
- ComEd proposed EV and EVCI rebates for all customer classes + EV charging rate class
- Ongoing proceeding at ICC

IEPA Charger Rebate Program (CEJA)

- Public and private organizations and companies eligible
- Install and maintain Level 2 or DCFC stations
- Up to 80% of the cost of the installation of charging stations
