


Biodiesel Production

Transesterification

Feedstock + Methanol + Lye = "Biodiesel" + Glycerin

The product is not considered biodiesel unless it meets all parameters of ASTM D6751 for B100




Renewable Diesel Production

Several pathways, most common is hydrotreating

Same feedstocks as biodiesel but produced in a refinery similar to diesel

Meets ASTM D975 for diesel

80% of renewable diesel goes to California







Biodiesel Benefits - Renewable and Clean

Average 74% carbon reduction with B100

Reduces particulate matter by 49% with B100


Better lubricity

Higher cetane

Non-toxic

Biodegradable

Higher flash point than diesel, safer to handle

NOx may increase depending on engine type and duty cycle





Biodiesel Benefits - Available now for heavy duty

Can be used in any diesel engine immediately

Uses existing infrastructure

B20 blend instantly achieves a 15% carbon reduction


















EPA Approved Biodiesel Feedstocks




Feedstock Composition in 2022

Can we grow more feedstock?

Canola Oil

- Recently approved pathway for renewable diesel
- Can be grown as a winter crop

Soybean Oil

- Currently around 50% of US soybeans get exported
- 1 billion gallons of US crush capacity coming online in the near future
- Steadily increasing yields = more bushels of beans on the same acreage






IL Biodiesel - Availability

6.25% sales tax is exempt for certain blend thresholds

- B10 since 2003
- B13 tax incentive started April 1, 2024
- B16 starting April 1, 2025
- B19 starting April 1, 2026
- B11 in winter (December through March)
- Around 85% of retailers sell biodiesel blends year round to get the tax credit
