Indiana Avenue (31st-55th)

- Long-standing traffic safety issues
- Deadly speeds & dangerous behaviors by motorists
- ► Indiana Ave is planned for resurfacing
- Upcoming project provides opportunity to slow vehicle speeds and improve safety for neighbors





Making Indiana Safer and More Comfortable for Everyone

- Traffic safety concerns from the neighborhood date back years
- People are driving at deadly speeds every day
- Wider than necessary street creates challenges for people crossing
- Drivers do not stop for people to walk across the street
- ▶ The worst crashes are caused by people from outside the neighborhood



People are Driving at Deadly Speeds along Indiana Avenue Every Day

Between 7am & 8am 95% of over 30 MPH 38% of over 40 MPH Top speed over 70 MPH

These are FATAL SPEEDS



Indiana is very wide, making it challenging to cross the street

of cars <u>did not stop</u> for people trying to walk across the street

Throughout Chicago, wider streets see 17x more fatal crashes than narrower ones



The worst crashes are being caused by people from outside the neighborhood

70%

of drivers who have caused an injury-producing traffic crash <u>live outside the</u>
neighborhood



Indiana Ave Over the Last Five Years (2019-2023)

704 total crashes333 people injured1 person killed





Proposed Changes



- ► Remove one of the 3 car lanes Narrowing the street for safer speeds and make it easier to walk across Indiana
- ► Install concrete curb extensions Improving the visibility for people walking across Indiana and slowing cars turning onto and off Indiana
- ▶ Add bus bulbs Providing more space for people to wait at bus stops on Indiana
- Reuse excess space Provide space for people to safely bike on Indiana



Remove one of the 3 car lanes

- Narrowing the street to slow cars and make it easier to walk across Indiana
- Encourage slower vehicle speeds
- Shorted distance people must walk to cross the street







Install concrete curb extensions

- ► Reduce the crossing distance for people walking intersections by up to 55%
- Cut the exposure to moving traffic
- ► Improve the visibility for people walking across Indiana
- Slow cars turning onto and off Indiana





Add bus bulbs (North of 35th)

- Providing more space for people to wait at bus stops on Indiana
- Will keep the sidewalk clear for people walking
- ► Improves bus travel times
- Also act as curb extensions






Reuse excess space


- Provide space for people to bike safely on Indiana
- Discourage people from biking on the sidewalk




