Illinois EV Rebate Program (CEJA)

- Runs 10/28/2025 to 1/31/2026- LINK
 - NEW: Personal EVs \$4000 for low income, \$2000 otherwise
 - Low-income credit determined by county
 - Income limits: < 5x federal poverty line</p>
 - Vehicle < \$80,000</p>
 - Funds go fast (\$14 MM total)





Illinois EV Charger Rebate Program (CEJA)

- The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) offers grants to public and private entities for the installation and maintenance of publicly available Level 2 and direct current (DC) fast chargers. Rebate
- Awards may cover up to 80% of the eligible project costs.
- Additional rebates are available for EV chargers deployed in underserved and environmental justice communities.

- \$44 MM remaining details TBA





Volkswagen Mitigation Program

- Consent decree between US and VW
- VW required to pay \$15 BB for cheating on emissions testing
- Illinois received \$108 MM, spent all





Electric Vehicle Fleet Fee Exemption

• State of Illinois charges a \$20 per vehicle fee on fleets of 10 or more vehicles. Electric vehicles are exempt from this fee. LINK

- May be local or utility-based programs (in addition to ComEd)

- Database of State Incentives for Renewables and Efficiency (DSIRE - NC) <u>LINK</u>





Federal Incentives

- EV tax credit ended 9/30/2025 for personal, commercial and used EVs
- <u>Personal Alt Fuel Refueling Property Tax Credit</u> low income only <u>LINK</u>
 - Must be in service by June 30, 2026
 - 30% up to \$1000
 - Based on eligible <u>census tract</u>
- Commercial Alt Fuel Refueling Property Tax Credit low income only -LINK
 - Must be in service by June 30, 2026
 - 30% up to \$100,000






Federal Incentives

- National EV Infrastructure Program (NEVI) back in play LINK
 - 80% of TIC
 - 4 DCFC, 150 kW
 - On Alt Fuel Corridor.
 - IL authorized for \$147 MM
 - IIJA funding put on hold Feb 2025 and reauthorized Sept 2025
- Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant Program (CFI)
 - Illinois has been approved ~ \$45 MM 3 tranches (State, Chicago and MMC)
 - IIJA funding put on hold Feb 2025
 - Some movement for first tranche, rest still on hold
- Other (DOT)
 - IIJA funding Put on hold Feb 2025
